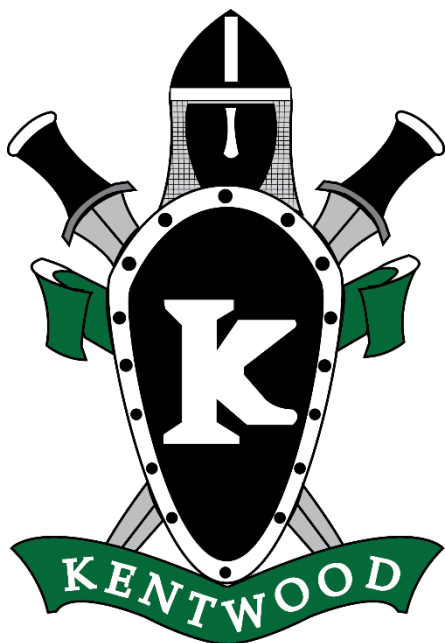

As reciprocal program, the student's family will host their family's student counterpart the same summer.

- Opportunities for eight to ten-day exchanges with Japan are open to students currently in 8th - 10th grade.
- The Norway committee is seeking students currently in 9th – 11th grade for two-week long exchanges.
- A three-week exchange with China is open for High School students preferably in 9th – 10th grade.

Students must fill out an application, attend a family orientation meeting and be interviewed. Those interested are encouraged to start the process by completing our one-page application, the form takes about 15 minutes. Applications will start to be reviewed in mid-January 2017, with deadlines shortly thereafter.
