**OBJECTION TO DISCLOSURE OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT INFORMATION TO  
MILITARY RECRUITERS**

The Kent School District is required by law to give high school students' names, addresses, and telephone listings to military recruiters when requested. (*§9528 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. §7908), as amended by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, and 10 U.S.C. §503, as amended by §544 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002.*)

Parents/guardians and students 19 years of age or older have the option to require that the student's name, address, and telephone listing is not disclosed to military recruiters.

If you do not want the Kent School District to disclose your student's name, address, and telephone listing to military recruiters you must annually notify the school principal in writing. You may complete the form below and return it to the student's school.
