4. Describe the action steps the school/district will take to reduce the opportunity gap in student possession of ASB cards and/or participation in extracurricular activities for the up coming school vear.

The district needs to have a better plan in place to access the Free Meal/Fee Waiver application for families to complete on line, not just a hard-copy that it lost, or difficult for families to complete. Push to have an online application that will be sent directly to the district instead of a paper copy to download and print off. Our soccer team created an extra boys team to allow the over flow of cut students to participate. Offer more clubs of interest to become an ASB charter, involving gender mixed attendance. We plan to survey students and send out club and athletic awareness via email to inform of participating. Work on the language barriers to support families needs in understanding what is available. Add the ASB waiver information to our monthly newsletter. A plan to ensure all 73% Free/Reduced students complete the waiver by having the application available during fall Open House. In August upon returning, send out a simple message by email and Skyward encouraging families that receive State assistance to apply for their children's free ASB and to sign up for a sport or a charter club.
