Elective Course Descriptions

Year-Long Elective Courses

Band, advanced MUB891	For continuing band students with emphasis on performance preparation and development of medium to advanced playing and reading skills. Activities include evening concerts, assemblies, district festivals, and field trips. School and evening performances are part of the grade for this class. Class fee.
Orchestra, advanced MUO891	Designed for continuing orchestra students to provide advanced large-group, individual and small-ensemble instruction. Activities include evening and daytime concerts, assemblies and field trips. School and evening performances are part of the grade for this class. Class fee.
Leadership* NDL800	Opportunity for students to develop their leadership skills as well as working through decision making, organization and communication via hands-on opportunities. Some activities may include development of peer lessons, running assemblies, and implementing service projects to create an improved school climate.
Yearbook* NDE801	Offers participation in gathering, preparing and publishing the personality and history a Meeker school year. Skills in editing, journalism, photography, printing layout, business management, surveying, data analysis and business management will be developed.

Semester Elective Courses

Art ART892	Introduces students to a variety of art mediums and techniques, including drawing, color theory, painting, printmaking and sculpture. This course includes information about art history, artistic careers, art criticism, and creative problem solving. Class fee for consumables.
Communication Technology IAT892	Teaches students the power of the media by learning to write, report, photograph, film, produce and edit video projects. Through school sponsored activities, students will become proficient in the practical skills needed to work as a team, generate story ideas, and understand and identify their audiences. Class fee for consumables.
Cooking HOM894	Learning the basics of food preparation, measurements and cooking. The class is project and activity oriented. Class fee for consumables.
Robotics TT0800	Students will learn foundational robotics and programming skills. Design, build and program real-world objects using the Engineering Process.
Mentorship NDM004	This class is through our GEM program (Glover Empowerment Mentorship) to support positive choices and emotional growth. <i>Graded Pass/Fail.</i>
