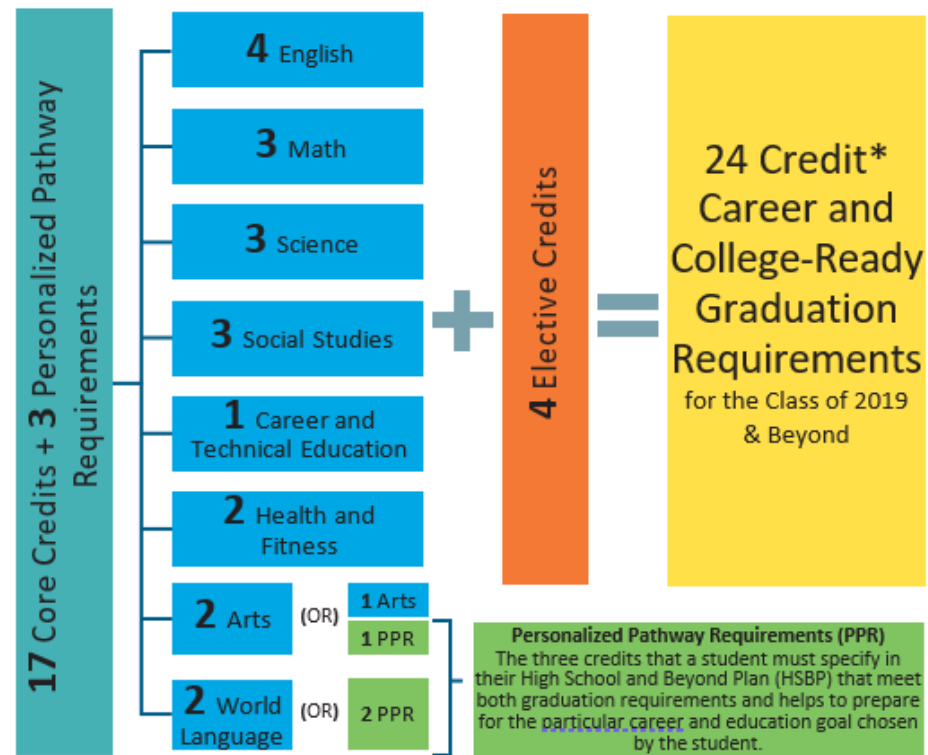


Graduation Requirements
