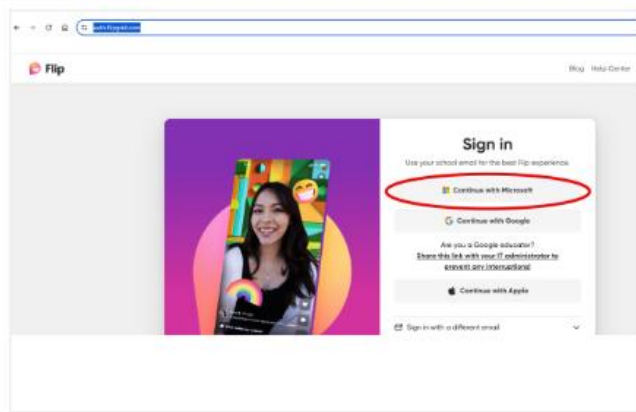


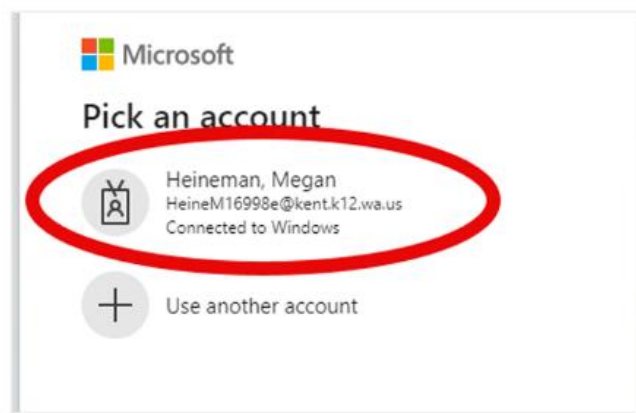

Complete these steps prior to delivering lesson 7.



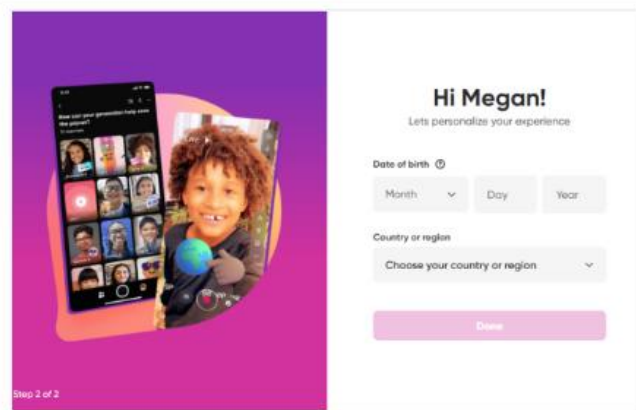

Visit <https://auth.flipgrid.com/> and use your KSD Microsoft Single-Sign-on to log into Flip.



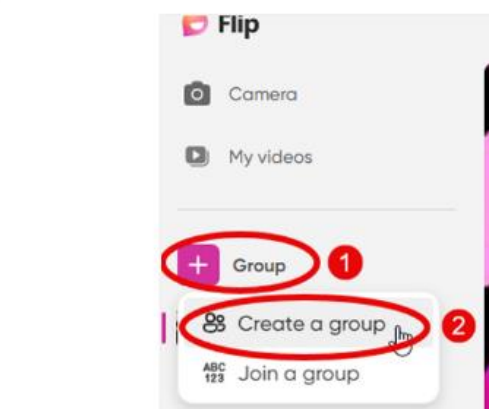

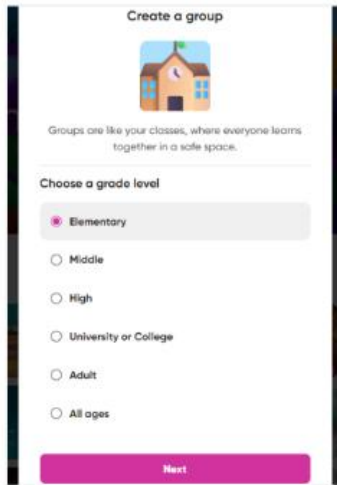
If this is your first time creating a Flip account, you will get a screen asking for your DOB and Country or region.

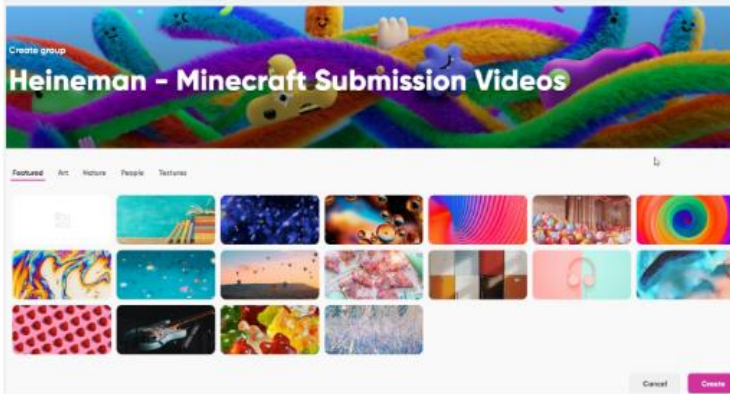
Create a group for your student submission videos for the Minecraft Challenge.

Click on the pink plus symbol on the left-hand side of the screen and then select create group to create a Flip group.

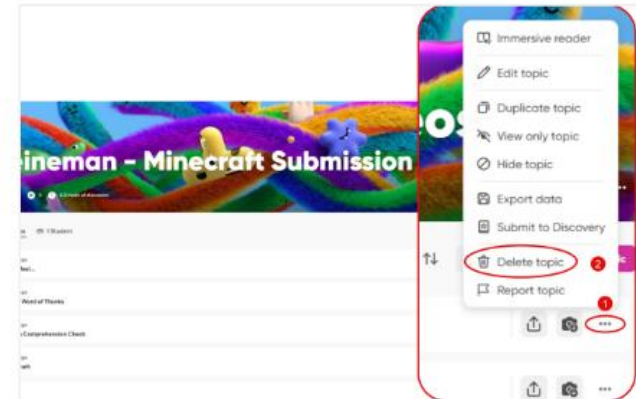
Select grade level and click next.

- Suggested Title: Last Name - Minecraft Submission Videos



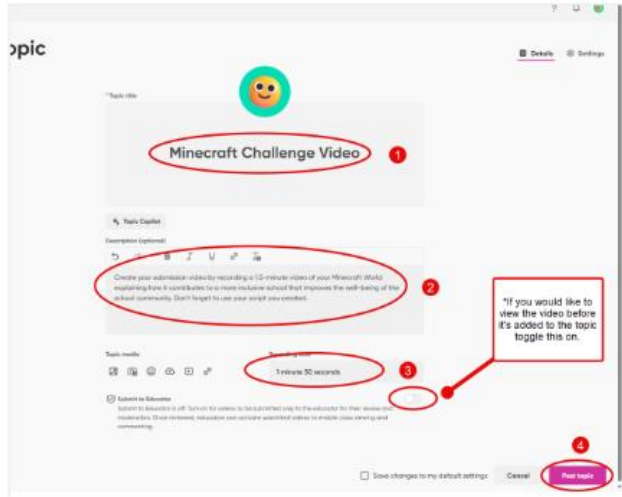

1. Add Title- Suggested Title: Minecraft Challenge Video.
2. Add a Description: - Suggested Description: Create your submission video by recording a 1.5-minute video of your Minecraft World explaining how it contributes to a more inclusive school that improves the well-being of the school community. Don't forget to use the script you created.
3. Set the video time limit to 1 minute and 30 seconds.
4. Select Post topic.

\*Best practice: Toggle on the "Submit to Educator" so you can view submissions before they post to the entire class. This steps allows you to ensure they are appropriate.
