School Supply List

The following supply list is voluntary. Jenkins Creek Elementary will make provisions for any student who cannot afford the supplies listed. All supplies should be labeled with your student's name; supplies are the personal property of your student.

The following list of school supplies is by grade level. Please keep in mind that consumables (ie. pencils, notebooks, and notebook paper) should be replenished as needed.

Kindergarten

- 1 - large Ziploc baggie labeled
- 1 - 8" x 5" supply box labeled with child's name
- 1 - pair of sturdy child scissors, labeled
- 1 - box of 16 crayons, labeled
- 1 - pkg of washable, non-scented, classic markers, labeled
- 3 - low odor, **BLACK** dry erase markers, put 1 marker in the supply box and the rest in the Ziploc baggie
- 4-8 glue sticks (Either 4 lg or 8 sml.) only keep 1 in supply box and the rest in the Ziploc baggie
- 2 - dozen #2 pencils (please sharpen ahead, replace as needed)
- 1 - Composition notebook
- 1 - two pocket folders
- Please place scissors, crayons and markers in the supply box.
- 1 - box of tissues

Second Grade

- 2 - dozen #2 Pencils Ticonderoga
- 2 - large pink erasers
- 1 - pkg of 12 colored pencils
- 1 - box of up to 24 crayons
- 1 - pair sharp 5" scissors
- 4 - two pocket folders
- 1 - pencil box— no bigger than 8 1/2 x 5 1/2
- 3 - glue sticks
- 1 - large Ziplock baggie—labeled
- 1 - dry eraser or old clean sock
- 3 - spiral notebooks, wide ruled
- 4 - Bold black, dry erase markers (EXPO) replace as needed
- 1 - pkg. wide ruled notebook paper

First Grade

- 1 - large Ziploc baggie
- 4 - dozen #2 pencils (please sharpen, replace as needed)
- 6 - black, dry erase markers (EXPO brand only)
- 1 - pair of sturdy child scissors
- 1 - box of 16 crayons
- 2 - boxes of colored pencils
- 4 - large pink erasers
- 1 - pkg pink pencil top erasers
- 10 - glue sticks
- 1 - pkg washable markers (set 10)
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- 1 - box Clorox wipes
- 2 - folders

Third Grade

- 3 - dozen #2 pencils (replace as needed)
- 1 - pair of 5" scissors
- 2 - large pink erasers
- 3 - spiral-bound notebooks, wide ruled
- 1 - composition notebook
- 4 - glue sticks
- 8 - black, low odor, dry erase markers
- 3 - highlighters (different colors)
- 1 - set of markers
- 1 - box of crayons (24 count or more)
- 1 - 12 inch wooden ruler (inches & centimeters)
- 1 package - Notebook paper - wide ruled
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes
- Supply **box** to hold materials

Fourth Grade

- 1 - set 5 tab notebook dividers (**Important**)
 - 2 - pkgs #2 pencils (replace as needed)
 - 1 - standard, sturdy 3-ring, notebook (with a 1" or 1 1/2" spine, "D" ring binder, no large or zippered notebooks)
 - 1 - box 48 crayons, OR 1 set colored pencils, or 1 set of thin tip color markers
 - 1 - pair 5" scissors
 - 1 - large pink eraser
 - 1 - wide tipped black permanent felt pen
 - 1 - 12 inch ruler with 3 holes (cm & inches)
 - 2 - glue sticks
 - 1 - green ballpoint pen (replace as needed)
 - 8 - dry erase (low odor) black or blue markers
 - 1 - dry erase eraser or old clean sock
 - 3 - spiral notebooks
 - 1 - composition book
- Notebook paper, wide ruled (replace as needed)
- 1-2 Boxes of tissues

Fifth Grade

- 2 - dozen #2 pencils (*replenish as needed)
- 1 - medium pair of scissors (not primary size)
- 1 - box of 8 to 12 colored pencils only*
- 1 - pkg. of 8-12 thin-tipped colored markers only *
- 3 - large glue sticks*
- 2 - yellow highlighters
- 2 - **low odor** dry erase markers*
- 1 - dry erase marker eraser (or old clean sock)
- 1 - Red - three prong, two pocket folder (work to be finished)
- 2 - Yellow/Orange 70 or 100 sheet spiral notebooks (Math)
- 1 - Green - 70 or 100 sheet spiral notebooks (Science)*
- 2 - Blue - 70 or 100 sheet spiral notebooks (ELA)*
- 1 - Red - 70 or 100 sheet spiral notebooks (Soc.St./Health)*
- 2 - Boxes of tissues*
- 1 - pkg lined notebook paper*
- 3 - Big pink erasers*

No binders

* **supplies may need to be replenished**

6th Grade

- 2 - dozen #2 pencils (replenish as needed)
- 1 - pair of scissors (medium to large size)
- 3 - plastic two-pocket folders with prongs
- 1 - box of 8 to 12 colored pencils
- 2 - large glue sticks (replenish as needed)
- 2 - highlighters (different colors)
- 3 - low odor dry erase markers
- 4 - 60+ sheet spiral notebooks (8 1/2 x 11 in.)
- 3 - composition book (100 sheets, wide ruled 9 3/4 by 7 1/2 in.)
- 1 - black sharpie
- 1 - large pink eraser
- 2 - Packages lined notebook paper 100+ per pack
- 1 - Pencil pouch (bag, not box)
- 1 - box of tissue
- 2-inch heavy duty binder with clear pocket for cover insert
- 1- package of 5 binder dividers
- Clorox/Lysol wipes canister

K-6 Integrated Program (students who receive special education support)

- 24 - pencils
- 4 - pink erasers
- 4 - dry erase markers
- 4 - glue sticks
- 2 - highlighters
- 1 - 1 gallon Ziploc bag labeled with students name
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- 1 package wide-ruled notebook paper (for 3rd to 6th)
- 2 packages graph paper (4th to 6th grade students who come for math)

ASC Primary and Intermediate

- Backpack (big enough to hold jacket and folder)
- 3 - large boxes of tissue
- 1 - box of gallon sized zip-lock bags
- 1 - box of sandwich sized zip-lock bags
- 4 - large-sized glue sticks
- 1 - 3 hole binder pencil pouch
- 1 - package of Crayola pipsqueak markers
- 1 - package of plastic spoons and forks
- 1 - package of paper plates (at least 100 count)
- 3 - containers of playdough
- Snack to share with class (goldfish, microwave popcorn)
